Mera and Island Climbing via Hinku Valley and Amphu Lapcha Pass (5,845 m) is the ultimate blend of trekking and climbing in the Himalayas of Nepal. Standing at an altitude of 6,476 meters, Mera Peak is renowned as the highest trekking peak in Nepal, while Island Peak is positioned at 6,189 meters. This expedition offers the opportunity to witness five of the highest mountain peaks in the world: Mount Everest (8,848 m), Mt. Kanchenjunga (8,586 m), Mt. Lhotse (8,516 m), Makalu (8,463 m), and Mt Cho Oyu (8,201 m). The remote valleys along the trekking trail, such as Hinku Valley and Imja Tse, add even more value to this tour.

Although Mera Peak is higher than Island Peak, it is generally considered less challenging and easier to climb. Island Peak climbing requires more technical knowledge than Mera Peak climbing, as it has more crevasses despite being shorter. The perfect combination of Mera and Island peaks, known as the twin peaks of Nepal, with the added challenge of Amphu Lapcha Pass, makes for a satisfying expedition that will provide memories for a lifetime.

As this tour encompasses two exceptional peaks over 6,000 meters, it is not for the faint of heart. Moreover, Amphu Lapcha Pass is a technically challenging pass that requires persistence and good health. However, Mera and Island peak climbing via Amphu Lapcha Pass is an exceptional opportunity to witness the wilderness of the Himalayan region of Nepal, with green grasslands, snow-covered peaks, including the one and only Mount Everest, perennial rivers, deep gorges, stunning glaciers, exhilarating suspension bridges, and more. These all contribute to making this high-altitude tour an exceptional adventure opportunity. Therefore, nature lovers, trekking enthusiasts, and adventure seekers find this Mera and Island Peak expedition highly appealing.
