This trek is designed for trekkers of all levels, as it only requires a good level of acclimatization and appropriate equipment, not an extensive previous trekking experience or a high degree of physical fitness.

As you journey through the Sagarmatha National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, you'll encounter an array of flora and fauna, including rare wildlife species that are unique to the region. With a flexible duration of 13 to 14 days, you can take your time to admire the beauty of the surroundings and adapt to the altitude at your own pace.
